- Ask someone to help you to drill a hole in the lid.
- Bend the string (approx 2cm long) and thread it through the hole from the inside of the cap.
- Tie a big Knot

②



- Screw the lid on tightly
- Carefully make some holes in the bottom of the bottle.
- Make 2 slits carefully, one on each side of the bottle

carefully make drainage holes

③



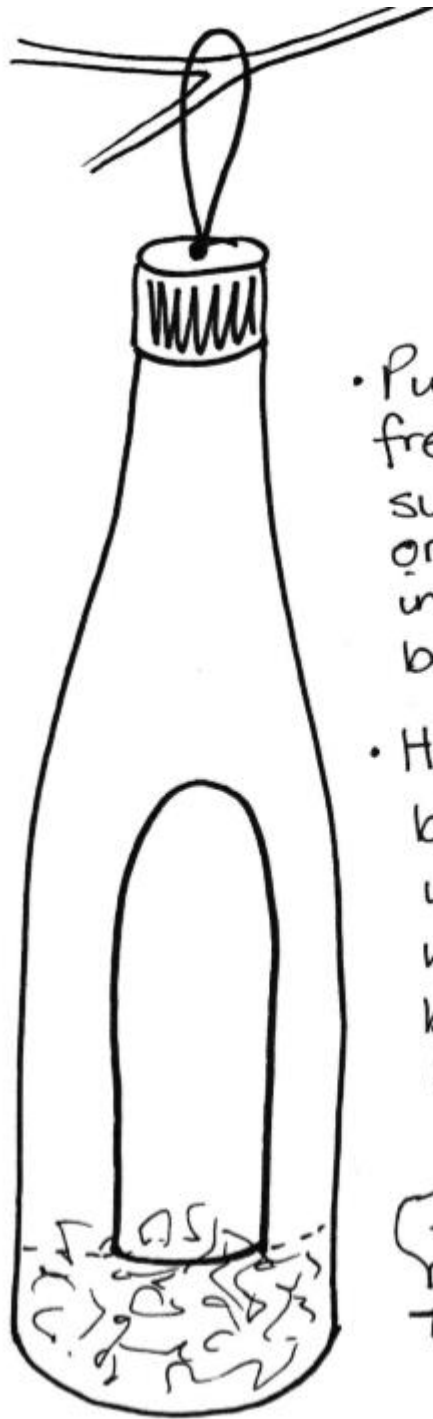
- Use the slits to start you off and carefully cut 2 windows on the opposite sides to each other.

- Use a file, sandpaper or an emery board (not your best one!) to smooth the edges

- Put some fresh seed, suet pellets, or scraps into the bottle.

- Hang your bottle feeder up and watch the birds investigating it!
